RE: Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Senior Housing Resident:

As you may have heard on the news, President Trump has declared a national emergency as a result of Coronavirus (COVID-19.) This development triggers heightened infection control practices and protocols as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC.) The **CHURCH OF CHRIST CARE CENTER AND ASSISTED LIVING** have restricted visitation, on our campus, as required by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS.) Based on federal guidance, no visitor will be permitted in our facilities, except for certain compassionate care situations, such as end of life.

As a Resident in a senior housing community, your risk is increased. Please call your primary care physician if you have:

- Signs or symptoms of a respiratory infection, such as a fever, cough, shortness of breath or sore throat;
- Within the last fourteen (14) days, had contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19, under investigation for COVID-19 or are ill with a respiratory illness;
- International travel, within the last fourteen (14) days, to countries with sustained community transmission.

For your safety, please:

- Wash your hands, often, for a minimum of twenty (20) seconds;
- Frequently sanitize commonly touched items/areas;
- Limit your visitors and anyone you come into close contact with;
- Safe visitation includes staying 6 feet away from anyone in your vicinity. No hand shaking or hugging;
- Postpone any non-essential visits, off campus, as well as having people into your apartment;
- Limit your movement within the campus area. The community center activities have been suspended until further notice. Please note includes the list below:
 - Temporary suspension of Focus Hope deliveries effective the next scheduled day in April;
 - Bingo at the community center;
 - Red Hatter's Mother's Day Tea planned for May 9, 2020.

Rent payments will now be made, for the time being, in the **LOCKED OUTSIDE BLACK MAILBOX** on the backside of the community center. Please be assured this is a locked box, as indicated, with Barbara only having a key. Any Resident that has been mailing their rent check, may continue to do so.

Due to the risk of exposure, **we are unable to assist with any emergency medical needs that you may encounter**. The pull cord wall system, nor the pendant system, will be available to you. Should you need medical attention, **please call 911**. Please keep your mobile phone, provided you own one, near you whenever possible. **Emergency Maintenance** requests will continue to be performed. However, please **postpone any non-essential Maintenance** requests until this crisis is over.

Please understand the situation, regarding COVID-19, is still evolving worldwide and can change rapidly. Please monitor the situation, carefully, through your news media daily.
